Here is recent communication on the construction project in Ivano-Frankivsk. The wonderful news is that the harsh winter weather "waited" until the roof was completed! A few days after the roof was completed a blizzard struck the Carpathians dumping "feet" of snow! Thank you for your prayers asking for good weather for this phase of construction. At this point we have all windows installed (the large windows for the auditorium are to be installed as this report goes out), the auditorium has been plastered, work on the plumbing is underway. We have partial funds to purchase the heating system and as soon as the remaining funds are donated, we will give the go-ahead on installing the heating system. Once the heating system is installed the Church should begin occupancy! Members will continue working on interior plastering and other tasks. They are working on electrical and plumbing but must have it inspected and approved by a registered State agency.



The progress and success of this project is exciting and incredibly amazing! "Now to Him who is able to do far more abundantly beyond all that we ask or think, according to the power that works within us, to Him be the glory in the church and in Christ Jesus to all generations forever and ever. Amen" (Ephesians 3:20-21).
