OUR SHIPPING EFFORTS DURING THE COVID SLOWDOWN



During September we were able to schedule two loadings. The brethren in Holly Springs, MS collected,

sorted and loaded a container that went to Ivano-Frankivsk, Ukraine. The value of that container was \$228,878.25. They loaded 19,590 pounds! From Montgomery, AL we loaded another container for Ivano-Frankivsk. That container was valued at \$266,640.00 and weighed 36,801 pounds!

We are working on several shipments that we hope will load in October. We will load from Montgomery two containers for Honduras and one container for Ivano-Frankivsk, Ukraine; from the Judsonia, AR warehouse we plan to send one container to Kherson, Ukraine. The end of the year is also a busy time for Larry & Betsy Brady and the brethren working with them. They are working on the container for Panama Missions that will ship their "Christmas Blessing Boxes" to orphans. The Holly Springs, MS brethren are also busily engaged in several actions during this time.

THE CHRISTIAN'S ANCHOR OF HOPE!

I received the following from our brother James Gammon. I think his thoughts should be highlighted during these stressful times.

"The world faces numerable uncertainties. Among the chief ones are those facing the USA, which has always been a nation rife with imperfections but has continued to be the world's steadying influence. Now, even many US individuals face economic, health, and political uncertainties. Somewhere in this list may be uncertainties facing your, your family, or friends, <u>et</u>. <u>al</u>.

"However, a few select have cause for optimism. Only the New Testamentconverted-Christian has a God-given reason for optimism. This hope is certain only if that Christian is faithfully cooperating as a servant with The Christ, from the innermost heart/thoughts to the outermost actions."

"The Christian's CERTAIN HOPE"

"Who have fled for refuge to lay hold upon the hope set before us: Which hope we have as an anchor of the soul, both sure and stedfast" (Hebrews 6:18-19).

"The noun 'hope,' when used in the New Testament, does not imply a wishful attitude but rather a joyous and confident expectation in something promised that will certainly come to pass—in most cases, something good. Note especially the few times it is used with a descriptive adjective.

"First, in a stirring benediction, Paul tells us that our good hope comes from both 'our Lord Jesus Christ himself, and God, even our Father' (2 Thessalonians 2:16). Furthermore, such hope is given to us along with 'everlasting consolation,' or comfort, that shall last forever. The Father and Son have done this 'through grace' that brings eternal salvation.

"Second, we are taught to be 'looking for that blessed hope, and the glorious appearing of the great God and our Saviour Jesus Christ' (Titus 2:13). This blessed hope can be none other than 'our Saviour, and Lord Jesus Christ, which is our hope' (1 Timothy 1:1). He will certainly return, and this return will be glorious.

"Third, we have a hope that is actively alive. 'The God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, which according to his abundant mercy hath begotten us again unto a lively hope by the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead' (1 Peter 1:3). We have been (past tense) born again from the dead just as surely as Christ has been raised from the dead, for His resurrection accomplished it.

"Our hope, under grace, is guaranteed by Jesus Christ: 'A better hope...by the which we draw nigh unto God' (Hebrews 7:19) than that which was possible under law. In fact, it is a glorious hope (2 Corinthians 3:11-12) by comparison. This kind of hope can be "an anchor of the soul."
