"YOU SET A GREAT CHRISTIAN EXAMPLE FOR US. YOU CANNOT IMAGINE HOW MUCH YOU HELP THE PEOPLE OF UKRAINE"

The month of October has concluded and its passage continues to lengthen the traumas of 2020. Highlighted in October are a number of worldly facts that irritate and distress Christians. During October I taught the Wednesday evening Auditorium class at the Dalraida Church of Christ. I used the Epistle to the Philippians for the class. Each week I summarized Inspiration's counsel on how the Christian can maintain "joy" in the midst of thieves seeking to steal that joy. The lessons are posted online and you are invited to go to the website and study this critical message.

We have been informed that our warehousing in Montgomery, AL will be lost. Another renter is willing to pay 14 times more a month that we were paying. We are now in frantic operations of scheduling as many loads as possible and then deciding what to do with the inventory remaining. At this point from Montgomery, before the Thanksgiving Holiday, we will load 4 containers (1 to Panama; 1 to Ukraine; 2 to Nigeria). In addition to operations out of Montgomery we are loading containers from Holly Spring, MS (1 to Nicaragua; 1 to Guatemala) and from Searcy, AR (1 to Ukraine).

In spite of this world's tribulations and anxieties, we find joy and rejoicing in the Lord's Church! In this newsletter you will find encouraging reports and announcements. As you take advantage of these you will find that joy that "passes all understanding in Christ Jesus"!

Thank you for your continued support in these efforts.

Greetings, dear brothers and sisters. Thank God, one more month has flown past and it seems like one day. Nothing bad has happened this month and no one from the Church has contracted the corona virus. Inna and Sviatoslav had caught a cold and were absent from services last Sunday. We always try to support and encourage them.

We continue assembling twice a week in our rented facility. Our Sunday worship attendance is 18-25. In addition to these there are 5 to 10 families who worship online with us. In those worshipping online there are some who have never been to Church among them. These are among those we have helped with money and food. THANK YOU for helping us survive such difficult times. We rejoice being united in spirit with you.

Our men Ruslan, Andrew, Pavlo and Oleksiy try hard to be a part of worship serving at the Lord's table. They help the members and are actively involved

BIBLE INSTITUTE AT BELA TSERKVA

In October a new wave of the coronavirus commenced. The educational institutions close their physical doors and most likely we won't be an exception. The numbers of infected are climbing up every day. The official statistics are lower than real life because the testing for covid is very pricey and even if one can afford it, there's a long waiting list. The hospital system in Ukraine is not capable to deal with the pressure and many doctors quit.

Our students and teachers are not panicking. Many Gospel meetings and seminars are postponed or hosted online. Another major problem, common to all the congregations all over the world - decreasing attendance. Congregations of 30-40 Christians currently congregate 20-30 at best.

May God keep you safe. The Bible Institute from Ukraine sends our love and many thanks for your financial support.

Your brother in Christ, Dennis Sopelnik in humanitarian work. We are about to receive two containers so we are busy making room in the warehouse to unload them. THANK YOU for the aid that you collect and for the containers you load and ship to Ukraine. Besides, doctors, teachers and all our members send their big thanks to all those that take part and help John Kachelman. You set a great Christian example for us. You cannot imagine how much you help the people of Ukraine. The majority of families cannot afford things that you send us. This aid provides opportunities for us to become closer to people and to preach the Gospel to them.

We just had elections and many people that now have elected power have assumed leadership positions. These are people that have been sympathetic and supportive of the Church. We pray for God to give them wisdom to govern the country and their locations as they should. Andriy Ivanovych, the contractor that helped us with construction, has become the Mayor of Yaremche. Anatoly Romanovych has become the Mayor of a united village community in the Tysmennytsia District (he was for a long time the Mayor of Starry Lysets). These are places we have worked with evangelizing and helping.

We want to use this opportunity and help improve life in the Lord so that many more people would repent and be baptized.

Thank you very much for your prayers and support. You are always in our prayers.

DR GARY JERKINS saw a need to train the young people through the work of local congregations in Ukraine. He initiated a camp that would teach biblical truths and promote leadership. That developed and now not only the camp continues but qualifying students are awarded scholarships to attend Institutes. This is funded by an annual sale. "I am not asking for your commitment, but your consideration should conditions permit a large group to travel without fear of falling ill to this contagion.
