This newsletter combines reports from September and October. The schedule was crammed with actions and no time to send a report for each month (and now it is November!). During these months, you had constant reporting on the mission trip and the amazing actions that developed. I continue to receive communication and updates from all involved in the meetings and contacts made. I know you were encouraged by the trip reports from Caleb, Gif and Nate as they sent back their impressions and thoughts.

After arriving back in Montgomery, I traveled to Pearl, MS where a nursing home donated 58 beds/mattresses for our shipping. Four congregations assisted in the project. These beds were shipped to Ghana. I hope to get a separate report out on this wonderful day.

Following the project in Pearl, MS I traveled to Columbia & Nashville, TN where I joined brethren who had taught a medical seminar with HMI in Ivano-Frankivsk (This is the seminar that Drs Gary Jerkins, Ron Swang and John Durham have conducted three times. They enlisted the partnership of many Christians in the medical profession and made a big impact in Ukraine! The seminar this year was the largest yet.). In Nashville we had a delightful meeting with the Majority Leader of the Ghanaian Parliament. This official came to explore the possibility of developing assistance for his country. Our dear brother Emmanuel arranged this meeting and is working to help the Lord's Church have a big impact in Ghana.

I returned from Tennessee and unloaded two truckloads of PPE supplies from CURE (Ft. Smith, AR). These supplies will be shipped to some, unknown at this time, place.

While I was in Ukraine the Montgomery warehouse was a beehive—we prepped, loaded and shipped out containers to Moldova, Nigeria and Panama. We also received another shipment of 27 pallets of the 8 oz hand sanitizer that we need to distribute quickly.

The trip to Ukraine was very profitable. The Church is doing well and the construction on the meetinghouse is progressing. They plan to begin meeting in the building at the New Year.

And, this is the time of the year where I need to send out support requests for 2022. I do appreciate those who financially support me so that the events, actions, projects and accomplishments that are reported every month are possible. THANK YOU!

Greetings to you, dear brothers and sisters in our Lord Jesus Christ. Another month has passed and brought us closer to meeting our Lord. Our life flies so fast that we fail to do a lot of things as we run out of time. But we thank God for everything, for all opportunities He presents to us every day. September was a good and warm month. The men of the congregation were able to catch up on construction works, and finished wiring of the first floor. Now we are getting the auditorium ready. If everything goes as planned and without a hitch, then we would like to have our first worship assembly in our new assembly hall in December. We are bringing all our strength into play to reach this goal.

We thank you for our brethren who come to teach classes here – brother John Durham who came a week ahead of John Kachelman and taught good Bible classes with practical illustrations. Then John Kachelman came and continued teaching on the Book of Colossians, which he started while he was here last time. His lessons built up and inspired the Church. Those were uplifting lessons that encouraged our Christians and reminded us of our unity in Christ. Besides, John Kachelman visited Yaremche where he gave an American flag to Mayor Andriy Ivanovych that our brother Chip McEwen had sent. The mayor was thrilled and gave many thanks and invited American youth for a visit to make plans for future joint events.

October is now over. The month was filled with joyful events. One more soul entered into the covenant with the Lord through immersion. Glory to our Creator for salvation that is still open to people who want to reconcile with God and receive forgiveness of sins.

Thank you so much for it!!! The sight orphanage is working hard to teach kids new things and letting them use new devices that you have helped to buy. Thank you very much to everyone for making it possible. Your work really helps change lives :):):

Most kids in the orphanage come either from very poor background or have grandparents taking care of them.



Together with John K we visited a children's shelter that had received different supplies from the Church to help the children and the staff in their hard but necessary job. John's son-in-law (Brian Coggins) has gathered a group of brothers and sisters interested in helping the needy. So they work with the Church and had sent toy bears made by sisters at Church. Children at the shelter were excited to get those toys. Besides, we brought office supplies, clothes, hygiene supplies and bought medicines for these children. On top of that, we bought table cloths and a commercial kitchen sink on behalf of the Church.

The Director of the shelter, Vasyl, used to say that all religious beliefs were good in their own way. After seeing the compassion, this time he said he was open to talk with us about the Lord and to hear the teachings of church of Christ.

John Kachelman also visited Mykulychyn, namely, the hospital which we had helped. Many people were thankful to the Lord for those helping them at such a trying time. John visited Ugornyky as well, where he met with Mayor Lubov. He gave a blood pressure device to their medical unit there. Unfortunately, with the beginning of a lockdown we could not visit either the school or kindergarten.

John was able to meet with doctors of a District Hospital here and the Dalraida church and those who support John's work gave funds to buy desks and cabinet for one of the doctor's offices where the men of the congregation had repaired the floor and walls.

Our brothers Caleb, Gif and Nate from Dalraida visited us as well. They edified the Church, and had a good fellowship with brothers and sisters. Our younger members were able to spend time with young Christians from America. Such fellowship is very good and instructive for young people allowing them to learn more about one another's life and ministry. Our Church grows and we need to see how big churches function. These three young brothers were a great example and encouragement.

We made a good progress with construction in October. The first floor is wired now and we have moved to the second floor. In October the boiler was purchased and a boiler house built. So now heating work has begun.

The Church here is very thankful to all helping us in our ministry as we preach the Gospel, share the Word of the Lord, and draw others to Church of Christ through our lives so they would find peace, joy and salvation for their souls.

Big thanks to the Hillsboro Church for the seminar they held at the Medical University where Ukrainian teachers and students could see American Christians in action. The seminar will help Ukrainian medical students in their challenging profession of helping people. We thank brothers Gary, Ron and Henry who labor in the mission field in Ukraine help us to serve our Lord in many ways. Big thanks to all who took part in the conference. We thank or dear sister Patrice and all participants and all those who made the conference possible.

We already have FIVE Christians in Zelena and there are four more families that come to classes that Svitlana and I teach every week. One family that had received aid from us before, asked for help again and said they would like to come to Bible classes. Those were Yura, his wife Masha, and their children Greetings from Yulia, all kids love learning more and practicing more. Yulia gave out many hair pins from our September delivery! The kids are very excited with these items! Thank you so much for everything, it's absolutely great!

She also says that she has some new students visiting her classes and there seems to be also a bit more younger ones. This makes it harder to work, as they need to be careful cutting the hair, but the earlier they start the better they will master things thru playing and such.

I have some photos from TB. They now have a new teacher. The previous one had to retire due to bad health issues. Now the lady who is teaching sewing seems to be very active and nice. Her name is Alexandra.

Misha and Natasha. We continue praying for Ivan and Lily's family. Ivan has a drinking problem, and Lily is thinking of being baptized.

The fourth wave of COVID lockdowns has been announced beginning November 1. We are being warned that events could be held and public places visited only by fully vaccinated people. Fines are high so we have decided to worship online until we can assemble again.

Big thanks to you, dear brothers and sisters, for making missionary trips to Ukraine possible. The Kingdom of God is growing all over the world despite hardships. God always has zealous hearts that are concerned and do all they can for His glory. We love you and thank you for prayers and support.

His place is Nayak Thanda which is 3 miles from Bhansuvada. we walked 3 miles and stayed 2 days and preached. But God is very kind to us he blessed our efforts. Two men and four women are baptised. All praise go to God. And all credit goes to you. As we find in Romans 10:15, and how shall they preach, unless they are sent? Brother you are feeding us every month and sending us to preach. Thank you sir, all credit goes to you and to sister Gennie. We thank with our whole hearts. I send few pictures tomorrow. Please pray for new souls.
