I will not go into detail as the monthly newsletters and special reports posted give the details. I just want to give you a summary of the successes that the Lord has made possible. It is very encouraging to sit back and review the past year and recognize the

amazing developments. Such was practiced by Paul as he returned from travels and eagerly shared the providential successes. "When they had arrived and gathered the church together, they began to report all the things that God had done with them and how He had opened a door of faith to the Gentiles" (Acts 14:27).

Those occupying critical positions in 2021

Our WAREHOUSE WARRIORS! We are blessed to have the energy and efforts of so many in the loading locations. These make the shipments possible. They collect, sort, pack and load TONS of benevolent supplies that are shipped worldwide. These are located in: Alabama (Montgomery); Arkansas (Judsonia/Searcy); Mississippi (Holly Springs; Columbus); TN (Columbia). Totals: 34 containers; 884,291 lbs; valued \$5,452,266.00

CHARITA SHTEYNBERG! I can confidentially state that if we did not have Charita as a partner we would do MUCH less than possible! Charita's logistical expertise is combined with her tenacity to achieve our objectives. She volunteers countless hours and exhausts her physical and emotional energy coordinating the logistics and wrestling the many problems trying to prevent success. She travels to various nations to represent our efforts and is constantly on overseas telephone calls about various actions. CONSIGNEES & IN-COUNTRY COORDINATORS! Success is possible only if the mission is 100% accomplished. Just loading a container is a small part of the mission. The most frustrating works occur "on the other end." We have to get multiple approvals and answer inane questions. Often, we are charged fees and fines that are not acceptable and the other end has to fight these charges. Without competent coordinators on the other end all would be lost. When we ship to a country this is the first critical position. Until this is confirmed there is no need to pursue further involvement. And, once a contact is identified we have to vet to make sure it is valid. In Ukraine Tanya does a superb job in this capacity for our shipments (handling funds; translating; fighting the opposition; confronting illegal charges; compiling reports; etc.). Also, in Ukraine, Anya is doing an exceptional job in coordinating the trade schools in the various orphanages. She is tasked with making sure each vocational school has adequate supplies. This involves sacrificing her personal time and energy to go and shop for the items. Without these two ladies the efforts in Ukraine would be greatly diminished.

SUPPORTERS! The reports are filled with amazing successes for the Lord, but these are possible only because of the generosity of those partnering by financial donations. Without these dollars little could be accomplished. I believe that no where else will you find the "return" on donations as you do in our efforts. When I was working with the DOS we could conservatively say that there was a 20:1 ratio on funds—for every 1-dollar there was a 20-dollar return! Why is it so great? Because <u>our operations are run on a volunteer basis!</u>




Highlights of special note from 2021:

- Two trips to Ukraine (March, October)
- Continue developing awareness of the Lord's Church in western Ukraine. This was greatly helped by the distribution of benevolence items. Also, significant progress was made toward the completion of the church building that will result in the Lord's Church being viewed in a much more acceptable way. The completion of construction so that occupancy certificates will be approved is occurring in spite of the opposition.
- The visionary work that brother *Jerry Max Morgan* has begun with the vocational training schools in orphanages in Ukraine has developed very well. This equips the children with

practical life-skills so when they have to leave the orphanage (at age 18) they can survive.

- We added another collection and distribution location for our efforts. This is in Columbia, TN and this location helped with efforts in the summer to the Apache reservations. Now Columbia, TN is added to locations in: Montgomery, AL; Judsonia, AR; Columbus, MS; Holly Springs, MS.
- Two books were published and added to AMAZON'S listing. One was a revision of my commentary on Colossians and the second was the masterful work by brother G.K. Wallace on the liberal/progressive errors disturbing the Lord's Church. Although brother G.K.'s





presentation was in 1963 it is clearly applicable in today's post-modern age. When I was a student at Freed-Hardeman, brother Gardner made this book available to every student. I have profited from it for decades. Here is a note from Ivan regarding the efforts to obtain the occupancy certificates for the Church building: "Hello brother, thank you for your inspiring letter. In our country, with these bureaucrats, it is very difficult to quickly do something or decide something. We continue to furnish all information requested to get the occupancy approval. We continue to work on the construction of the church building. We are currently working on the ground floor. We are preparing racks for mounting the ceiling in the hall, preparing the toilet room for laying tiles and installing sinks and toilet faucets. Also, in the rooms for classes with children, we prepare for laying tiles and installing ceilings. We are now told these have to be 100% completed before certificate is given. After a time they will run out of delay. We pray for God's help so this is soon."
