The war forced us to leave our city on the 15th day of hostilities. Ivano-Frankivsk became our location. this city was familiar to us and plus there is a strong church where not only our brothers and sisters but also friends live. this city is located at 800 ml from Kramatorsk. They showed us hospitality and helped with resettlement. we stayed two families (7 people) in a three room apartment. thanks to the local community. 10 people came from Kramatorsk, of them from our community.

The men of the church blocked the window in the hope of protecting it from destruction during the bombing. We will keep in touch with everyone who left as much as possible. every evening we have a meeting of the Kramatorsk brothers on the viber phone and discussions and prayers.
